Non-Accepted Items include:

- Hazardous Waste
- Glass
- Paper

Items that have a circuit board and no characteristics of the non-accepted items will also be accepted.

This event is free (unless otherwise noted for certain items as listed above) and intended for the Village of Mattawan Residents. The physical locations are at 56720 Murray Street. Items that are recycled are done so sustainably, transparently, and securely.
