22899 Freedom Lane.**

Items must be bagged, boxed or bundled, for easy handling. Household doors, furniture, mattresses and carpeting will be accepted as long as:

- Carpeting must be rolled and securely tied in no longer than 4 ft sections
- Mattresses/box-springs must be sealed in a plastic mattress bag
- Bags may not exceed 35 lbs. and trash cans may not exceed 75 pounds
- No individual items over 4 feet in length, 3 feet wide or 3 feet high or weigh over 100 lbs.
- Tires. Passenger car tires only.

SEE REVERSE FOR RESTRICTIONS

THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS APPLY

No refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners.

No auto parts, batteries, or rims, tractor tires

No materials that are prohibited from disposal in type 2 landfills such as paints, solvents, oils, etc.

No propane cylinders

No household garbage or yard waste such as grass clippings, and tree trimmings.

No roofing shingles.

No loose lumber, or building materials

No burning barrels/ashes

No dead animals

No concrete, dirt, rocks, sod or stumps, sawdust, asphalt or bricks

No iron or steel, cast iron bathtubs

No medical waste

No ammunition or fireworks

No Hot tubs

No windows
